FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Insurance**, **Financial Institutions and Professional Registration (DIFP)** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Oversight assumes Section 326.289.10 removes a charge fee for oversight of peer reviews. According to DIFP, the MOSBA (Missouri State Board of Accountancy) has not charged a fee for this service. The MOSBA has designated the Missouri Society of Certified Public Accountants (MOCPA) as the Administrating Entity for oversight of peer review work product in Missouri. Thus, the MOCPA as the Administering Entity collects fees for the oversight instead of the MOSBA.

Oversight notes that the Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration has stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.
