### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials at the **Office of the State Courts Administrator**, the **Department of Natural Resources**, the **Office of the State Public Defender**, the **Office of Prosecution Services** and the City of Kansas City each assume no fiscal impact to their respective organizations from this proposal.

**Oversight** notes that the Office of the State Courts Administrator, the Department of Natural Resources, the Office of the State Public Defender, the Office of Prosecution Services and the City of Kansas City have each stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their respective organizations.
