## **FISCAL ANALYSIS**

### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Office of Administration** and the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Veterans Commission** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

**Oversight** notes that the Office of Administration and the Department of Public Safety - Missouri Veterans Commission has stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note for these agencies.

### **Senate Amendment 1**

**Oversight** notes this amendment designates the paw paw tree as the state fruit tree of Missouri and the hellbender salamander as the official endangered species for the state of Missouri.

In response to similar proposals from this year (Perfect SB 210), officials from the **Office of Administration** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

**Oversight** notes that the above mentioned agency has stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

### **Senate Amendment 2**

**Oversight** notes this amendment designates May 26<sup>th</sup> of each year as the Battle of St. Louis Memorial Day.

In response to similar proposals from this year (HB 338), officials from the **Office of Administration** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

**Oversight** notes that the above mentioned agency has stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

Senate Amendment 3

**Oversight** notes this amendment designates November as “Cardiovascular Disease and Type 2 Diabetes Awareness Month” in Missouri.

In response to similar proposals from this year (HB 1161), officials from the **Office of Administration** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

**Oversight** notes that the above mentioned agency has stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.
