FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Insurance**, **Financial Institutions and Professional Registration**, the **Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan**, the **Department of Public Safety**- **Missouri Highway Patrol** and the **Missouri Department of Conservation** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

In response to a similar proposal from this year (HB 492), officials from the **Department of Transportation** assumed the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Oversight notes that the above mentioned agencies have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

Officials from the **Office of Administration** defer to the Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan to estimate the fiscal impact of the proposed legislation on their organization.
