FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

§§208.244 and 640.090 - Reports to the joint committee on government accountability

Oversight notes that the Department of Natural Resources (DNR), the Department of Social Services (DSS), the Missouri House of Representatives and the Missouri Senate have each stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their respective organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these organizations.

Oversight notes the provisions of §208.244 require the DSS to provide their annual report to the president pro tempore of the senate and the speaker of the house of representatives rather than the joint committee on government accountability. Therefore, there would be no savings to DSS.

In addition, the implementation impact report prepared by the DNR pursuant to §640.090 will still be submitted to governor, the president pro tempore of the senate and the speaker of the house of representatives. The provisions of this proposal simply removes the report from being submitted to the joint committee on governmental accountability. Therefore, there would be no savings to DNR.
