FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Missouri House of Representatives** and **Missouri Senate** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective bodies.

Oversight notes that Section 610.026.1 (3) allows the legislative bodies (or their members) to collect a minimum fee of five dollars for a request of public records. Oversight is unable to estimate how many requests, if any, will be made for records or how many agencies will implement the policy. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a positive zero to unknown fiscal impact to the state (General Revenue), but will assume the additional amount would be less than \$100,000 per year.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This act authorizes the closure of public records under the Missouri Sunshine Law that are retained by the office of a member of the General Assembly that are related to a constituent of the member.

When responding to a request for records, this act authorizes a legislative body to charge a minimum fee of five dollars for any request where there are allowable fees of less than five dollars. Such five dollar fee shall be in place of any allowable fee of less than five dollars. A request for records shall be considered withdrawn if the requester fails to remit all fees within thirty days of a request for payment by the public governmental body.

This act has an emergency clause.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
