Officials from the and **Columbia/Boone County Public Health and Human Services and St. Louis County Department of Public Health** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

In response to a previous version, officials from the **Cooper County Public Health Center and Boone County Sheriff’s Office** each assumed the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Oversight notes that the agencies mentioned above have each stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note for these agencies.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other local public health agencies and law enforcement agencies were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. The proposed legislation appears to have no direct fiscal impact.


This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
