#### FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials at the **City of Columbia** assume there would be no fiscal impact for the City of Columbia unless the City Council authorized a ballot issue and voters approved the proposition. It is not possible to estimate the costs, but they would include, at least, the cost of the election; the broadband bidding processing; the broadband service contract; administration and operation of the district (staff, supplies, furniture, office space); and possibly audit costs.

Officials at the **Office of the Secretary of State** and the **Department of Commerce and Insurance** each assume no fiscal impact to their respective agencies from this proposal.

Officials at the City of Kansas City assume no fiscal impact from this proposal.

**Oversight** notes the Office of the Secretary of State, the Department of Commerce and Insurance and the City of Kansas City have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

**Oversight** only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other cities and counties were requested to respond to this proposed legislation, but did not. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.

**Oversight** notes that some of the costs mentioned by the City of Columbia could be offset through grants, loans, bonds, or user fees. Oversight notes per §71.1000.6, the district shall not levy, assess, apportion, or collect any tax upon property within the district to offset these costs. Oversight assumes the two or more municipalities would not take action from this proposal unless there was an economic benefit to the municipalities and approval by the majority of voters to form a broadband infrastructure improvement district. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a \$0 impact to Local Political Subdivisions for this proposal.

## FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

Small businesses that service broadband internet services within these districts could have a direct fiscal impact as a result of this proposal.

#### FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This act allows two or more municipalities to form a broadband infrastructure improvement district for the delivery of broadband internet service to the residents of such municipalities. A district created under the act shall have to power to contract with a broadband internet service provider to provide broadband internet service to the residents of the district.

A district may finance the provision or expansion of broadband internet service through grants, loans, bonds, or user fees, but shall not have the power to levy, assess, apportion, or collect any tax upon property within the district nor upon any of its members.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
