FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Missouri Senate (SEN)** state, as written, the bill does not allow for actual and necessary expenses to be reimbursed to attend committee meetings. Therefore, it would appear to be no fiscal impact. However, the Senate assumes the our Senators will attend meetings and will ask for reimbursement, creating a fiscal impact. In summary, SEN assumes a negative fiscal impact to the Senate Contingency appropriation of approximately \$533 per meeting.

The proposed legislation appears to have no direct fiscal impact.


This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
