ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, Missouri Department of Conservation, Office of the State Courts Administrator, Attorney General's Office, and Office of Administration** each assume this proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective agencies.

Officials from the **City of Ballwin, City of Corder, City of Kansas, City of Springfield, and City of Saint Louis – Budget Division** each assume this proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Officials from the **Northwest Missouri State University, State Technical College of Missouri, University of Missouri, and Missouri State University** each assume this proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Oversight notes the above mention agencies, universities, and local political organization have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other school districts, counties, cities, colleges, and universities were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION
