ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, Office of Administration, Missouri Department of Conservation,** and the **Department of Transportation** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Officials from the Cities of **Ballwin, Corder, Kansas City, O’Fallon, Springfield,** and **Saint Louis – Budget Division** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective local government.

Officials from the **Missouri State University, Northwest Missouri State University, State Technical College of Missouri, University of Central Missouri,** and **University of Missouri** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective institutions.

Oversight notes the above state agencies, local governments, and colleges each assume the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other school districts, counties, and cities were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION
