ASSUMPTION

§9.052 – Law Enforcement Appreciation Day (first Friday in May)

In response to a similar proposal from 2021 (HB 450), officials from the **Office of Administration** and **Department of Public Safety** each assumed the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

§9.169 – Random Acts of Kindness Day (August 31st)

In response to a similar proposal from 2021 (HB 202), officials from the **Office of Administration** assumed the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their respective organization.

Oversight notes that the above mentioned agency has stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

§9.225 – Mark Twain Day (November 30th)

In response to a similar proposal from 2021 (HB 894), officials from the **Office of Administration** assumed the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Oversight notes that the above mentioned agency has stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

§9.227 – Iron Curtain Speech Day (March 5th)

In response to a similar proposal from 2021 (HB 893), officials from the **Office of Administration** assumed the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Oversight notes that the above mentioned agency has stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

§9.291 – John Jordan ‘Buck’ O’Neil Day (November 13th)

In response to a similar proposal from 2021 (HB 869), officials from the **Office of Administration** assumed the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Oversight notes that the above mentioned agency has stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

§9.301 – Fox Trotter Week (first full week in September)

In response to a previous version, officials from the **Office of Administration** and **Missouri Department of Agriculture** each assumed the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Oversight notes that the above mentioned agencies have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

§9.306 – Walthall Moore Day (May 1st)

In response to a similar proposal from 2021 (HB 522), officials from the **Office of Administration** assumed the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Oversight notes that the above mentioned agency has stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

§9.309 – Limb Loss Awareness Month (April)

In response to a similar proposal from 2021 (HB 404), officials from the **Office of Administration** assumed the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Oversight notes that the above mentioned agency has stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

§9.323 – Pioneering Black Women’s Day (March 26th)

In response to a similar proposal from 2021 (SB 610), officials from the **Office of Administration** assumed the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Oversight notes that the above mentioned agency has stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

§9.339 – Hazel Erby Day (September 22, 2021)

In response to a similar proposal from 2021 (HCR 47), officials from the **Office of Administration** assumed the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Oversight notes that the above mentioned agency has stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION
