FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Office of the Secretary of State** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Officials from the **Kansas City Election Board, Platte County Board of Elections, and St. Louis County Board of Elections** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Oversight notes according to the National Conference of State Legislators (NCSL), as of to date, 16 states and the District of Columbia (for a combined total of 196 electoral votes) have passed National Popular Vote bills into law. Oversight assumes that the Secretary of State is responsible for certifying presidential electors and the local election authorities have the resources in order to comply with this proposal. Therefore, Oversight will zero fiscal impact on this note.

Oversight notes that the above mentioned agencies have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION
