FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

In response to similar legislation from this year, HB 670, officials from the **Office of the State Treasurer (STO)** assumed no fiscal impact from this proposal. However, as of June 30, 2020, there was a balance of \$2,557.00 in the Missouri State Archives-St. Louis Trust Fund (0770). The STO assumes that the existing balance in the Missouri State Archives-St. Louis Trust Fund (0770) will be transferred into GR and will have a positive fiscal impact of \$2,557.00.

Officials from the **Office of Administration** and the **Office of the Secretary of State** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

Officials from **St. Louis City** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note.

Oversight notes the Missouri State Archives – St. Louis Fund (0770) had an ending balance of \$2,557 as of 06/30/20. In July 2020, there were receipts of \$.31 and a disbursement/transfer out of \$2,557.31 which made the account zero at the end of July. There has been no activity as of 12/31/20. Below is a list of the following activity for the fund in the previous fiscal years:

FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This act repeals the Missouri State Archives-St. Louis Trust Fund as well as provisions of law authorizing the Secretary of State to open and maintain an archival facility in St. Louis and allowing the Secretary of State to receive any moneys or properties for the development or maintenance of such a facility.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
