#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the Department of Commerce and Insurance, the Department of Social Services, the Missouri Department of Conservation, the Missouri Department of Transportation, the Office of Administration, the Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan, and the cities of Claycomo, Corder, Kansas City, O'Fallon, Springfield each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note.

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol** defer to the Missouri Department of Transportation for the potential fiscal impact of this proposal.
