FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Section 100.265 – Creation of the Missouri Development Finance Board

Officials from the **Missouri Department of Economic Development**, the **Office of the Governor**, the **Office of the State Treasurer**, and the **Missouri House of Representatives**, do not anticipate this proposed legislation will cause a fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. **Oversight** assumes the increase in related reimbursable expenses due to the Commission adding additional members will not increase expenses materially.

Section 215.020 "Missouri Housing Development Commission"

Officials from the **Missouri Department of Economic Development**, the **Office of the Governor**, the **Department of Natural Resources**, the **Office of the Governor**, the **Office of the State Treasurer**, the **Missouri Department of Agriculture**, and the **Missouri House of Representatives** do not anticipate this proposed legislation will cause a fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. **Oversight** assumes the increase in related reimbursable expenses due to the Commission adding additional members will not increase expenses materially.

Bill as whole:

Officials from the **Missouri Senate** anticipate a negative fiscal impact to reimburse senators for travel to board and commission meetings. In summary, it will cost approximately \$611.56 per meeting. **Oversight** assumes the expenses of the Joint Contingent Appropriation would be minimal and not material enough to include in this fiscal note. Therefore, for purposes of this fiscal note, **Oversight** will not report a fiscal impact as it relates to both sections.


