FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Oversight notes that in similar proposals from the current session, officials from the Attorney General's Office, the Department of Commerce and Insurance, the Department of Economic Development, the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, the Department of Health and Senior Services, the Department of Mental Health, the Department of Natural Resources, the Department of Public Safety (DPS), Division of Alcohol and Tobacco Control, the DPS, Missouri Gaming Commission, the Missouri Department of Agriculture, the Missouri Department of Transportation, the Office of Administration and the Office of the Governor each assumed the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Oversight only reflects the responses received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, colleges were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A listing of political subdivisions included in the Missouri Legislative Information System database is available upon request.

Oversight notes that the above mentioned agencies have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.
