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FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from **Joint Committee on Public Employee Retirement (JCPER)** state this proposal has no direct fiscal impact to the Joint Committee on Public Employee Retirement. The review of this proposal indicates it would not create a "substantial proposed change" in future plan benefits as defined in Section 105.660(10).

Officials from **MoDOT & Patrol Employees' Retirement System (MPERS)**, state this proposal, if enacted, would stagger the terms for MPERS' elected trustees. Staggering the terms of the elected trustees would serve to spread out the natural turnover of elected board members, so that all four elected trustees would not leave the board at the same time. MPERS' Board is supportive of this change. There is no fiscal impact associated with the enactment of this legislation.

Officials from the **Missouri Department of Transportation** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Oversight notes that MPERS has stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.
