FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Missouri Department of Agriculture (MDA)** assume the department will require up to 1.5 FTE (Agriculture Marketing Specialist) to accomplish the requirements of this section. The annual salary for this position is \$41,918. These position(s) would require General Revenue funding, as well as fringe benefits. Both positions would require systems equipment and computer equipment.

Oversight does not have information to the contrary and therefore, Oversight will reflect the cost of 1 FTE for MDA. In addition, Oversight will reflect the costs from General Revenue as the new "Missouri Hardwood Forest Product Promotion Fund" may not have the initial funding to cover the costs indicated by MDA. Oversight notes this fiscal note does not reflect the indirect positive benefits the state would receive from promoting the state's hardwood forest products.

Officials from the **Office of the State Treasurer** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for this office.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This bill requires the Department of Agriculture to promote Missouri hardwood forest products and educate the public on the value and benefits of these products. The Department may contract with a statewide association dedicated to the promotion of Missouri hardwood forest products to fulfill this requirement.

The bill also creates the "Missouri Hardwood Forest Product Promotion Fund" for the sole purpose of promotion and education regarding Missouri hardwood forest products.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
