ASSUMPTION

§191.1720 - "Missouri Save Adolescents from Experimentation (SAFE) Act" and gender transition procedures

Officials from the **Attorney General’s Office**, the **Department of Commerce and Insurance**, the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education**, the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol**, the **Department of Social Services**, the **Missouri Department of Conservation** and the **Missouri Department of Transportation** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

In response to a previous version, officials from the **Office of Administration - Administrative Hearing Commission**, the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** and the **Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan** each assumed the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note.

Small business health care providers could, under circumstance outlined in the proposal, be subject to administrative discipline or taken to court if they do not adhere to this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION

The proposed legislation appears to have no direct fiscal impact.


This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
