ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Attorney General’s Office**, the **Office of Administration - Administrative Hearing Commission**, the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education**, the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol**, the **Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan**, the **Missouri Department of Transportation** and the **Department of Commerce and Insurance** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

In response to a previous version, officials from the **Missouri Department of Conservation**, the **Department of Social Services**, the **Missouri Office of Prosecution Services** and the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Oversight notes that the above mentioned agencies have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

Small business health care providers could, under circumstance outlined in the proposal, be subject to administrative discipline or taken to court if they do not adhere to this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION

The proposed legislation appears to have no direct fiscal impact.


This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
