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## FISCAL ANALYSIS

## ASSUMPTION

Officials from the Missouri Ethics Commission (MEC) assume the the proposed legislation increases the per day late campaign finance report assessment amount from \$10.00 to \$20.00 with the exception of the 8-day before election report which will increase from $\$ 100.00$ to $\$ 200.00$. MEC provided the average total increase in General Revenue related to the increase in the per day late fee assessment amount for campaign finance reports is $\$ 65,035$ (average of the total dollar amount assessed in the last two years).

Oversight assumes that late fees assessed by MEC annually could vary in total. Therefore, Oversight will reflect more or less than the impact estimated by MEC in the fiscal note.

## FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

## FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This act modifies multiple provisions relating to ethics.
LOBBYIST REPORTS (SECTION 105.473)
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Under current law, lobbyists are required to file with the Missouri Ethics Commission (MEC) monthly expenditure reports. This act requires such reports to be made annually.

## LATE FEES ON CAMPAIGN FINANCE DISCLOSURE REPORTS (SECTION 105.963)

 Under current law, the executive director of the Missouri Ethics Commission is required to charge late fees of $\$ 100$ per day for candidate committees and $\$ 10$ per day for continuing committees, campaign committees, and political party committees for campaign finance reports required to be filed 8 days prior to an election. This act requires all committees to be charged $\$ 100$ per day in late fees for such reports. All other campaign finance reports will be charged a $\$ 20$ per day late fee, rather than $\$ 10$ per day as required by current law. Such fees shall be increased based on the increase in the cost of living, as provided in the act.LATE FILING FEES (SECTION 130.056)
The act raises the fine for filing any disclosure report late from $\$ 10$ to $\$ 20$ and provides for an increase based on the increase in the cost of living, as provided in the act.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
