#### **FISCAL ANALYSIS**

#### **ASSUMPTION**

§376.2070 – Insurance coverage for synthetic hormone therapy to be on same terms as bioidentical hormone therapy coverage

Officials from the Department of Commerce and Insurance, the Department of Social Services, the Missouri Department of Conservation, the Missouri Department of Transportation, the Office of Administration, the City of Kansas City, the City of Springfield and the Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety, Missouri Highway Patrol** defer to the MoDOT/MHP Health Care Board for response relating to the fiscal impact of this proposal on their organization.

**Oversight** only reflects the responses received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other cities and county officials were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not.
