ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization. Excusing an absence does not make the time claimable for Average Daily Attendance (ADA), thus no increase to the call of the Foundation Formula.

Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note.

Oversight does not anticipate a fiscal impact from this proposal. However, Oversight did not receive any responses from school districts related to this proposal. Oversight has presented this fiscal note on the best current information available. Upon the receipt of additional responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval to publish a new fiscal note.

Oversight only reflects the responses received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, numerous school districts were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not.
