ASSUMPTION

Officials from the Department of Commerce and Insurance, the Department of Health and Senior Services, the Department of Natural Resources, the Department of Revenue, the Department of Public Safety - Missouri Gaming Commission and the Missouri Highway Patrol, the Missouri Department of Transportation, Kansas City and the City of Springfield each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

In response to a previous version, officials from the Office of Administration - Administrative Hearing Commission, the Department of Social Services, the City of O'Fallon, the Blackwater Reorganized Common Sewer District, Metropolitan St. Louis Sewer District, Metropolitan Sewer St. Louis, Morgan County Pwsd, and South River Drainage District each assumed the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Oversight notes that the above mentioned agencies have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.
