FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

§§67.1421, 67.1422, 238.225 – Special Taxing Districts

Officials from the **City of Kansas** City state this proposal could have a negative fiscal impact on Kansas City in an indeterminate amount if the legislation makes it more difficult to establish community improvement districts and thereby impedes economic development.

Oversight assumes this could possibly make it harder to establish a Community Improvement District and/or a Transportation Development District. However, **Oversight** assumes this to be a potential *indirect* impact and will not show it on the fiscal note.

Officials from the **Department of Revenue**, the **Missouri Department of Transportation** and the **City of Springfield** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, **Oversight** will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

Oversight only reflects the responses received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other cities and counties were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A listing of political subdivisions included in the Missouri Legislative Information System (MOLIS) database is available upon request.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.

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
