FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

§1.486 – Anti-red flag gun seizure act

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Highway Patrol (MHP)** state the potential fiscal impact and legal liability the Patrol will be exposed to if the proposal is passed is unclear. With the limitations placed in section 1.486.4 and 1.486.5, this would appear to have a fiscal impact as it could eliminate grant money for certain task force officers.

The MHP has received federal grant monies for the last two <u>fiscal</u> years in the following amounts:

FY 2021 - \$733,074 FY 2022 - \$755,873

Oversight does not have any information contrary to that provided by MHP. Therefore, Oversight will reflect MHP's impact as \$0 or an Unknown loss of Federal funds. Oversight assumes the amounts related to confiscation of firearms, accessories or ammunition would not reach the \$250,000 threshold.

Officials from the **City of Kansas City** state this legislation could have a negative fiscal impact on Kansas City in an indeterminate amount if they were to not receive a grant pursuant to this legislation.

Officials from the **Branson Police Department** state there is the potential for a reduction in federal grants available to Missouri law enforcement depending on how this law would be interpreted.

Officials from the **St. Joseph Police Department** state there is potentially a negative fiscal impact due to losing funding.

Oversight notes the unknown impact for the City of Kansas City, the Branson Police Department, and the St. Joseph Police Department and is unable to project a statewide cost; therefore, Oversight will present a potential unknown loss of federal funding to local governments – political subdivisions.

Officials from the Attorney General's Office, the Missouri Department of Conservation, the Missouri Office of Prosecution Services, the Office of Administration, the Office of the State Courts Administrator, the City of O'Fallon, the City of Springfield, the Kansas City Police Department, and the Phelps County Sheriff's Department assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these entities.

Oversight only reflects the responses received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other cities, counties, and local law enforcement were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A listing of political subdivisions included in the Missouri Legislative Information System (MOLIS) database is available upon request.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This act establishes the "Anti-Red Flag Gun Seizure Act" which provides that any federal order of protection or other judicial order issued by a court to confiscate any firearm, firearm accessory, or ammunition from any law-abiding citizen shall be considered an infringement on the people's right to keep and bear arms.

Additionally, no public agency, political subdivision, or law enforcement agency shall receive any federal funding for the purpose of enforcing any federal acts or judicial orders confiscating any firearms, firearm accessories, or ammunition.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
