Officials from the Department of Public Safety (Missouri Highway Patrol, Office of the Director, Missouri Gaming Commission, Missouri National Guard, Missouri Veterans Commission, and State Emergency Management Agency), the Department of Commerce and Insurance, the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, the Department of Health and Senior Services, the Department of Mental Health, the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, the Department of Revenue, the Department of Social Services, the Missouri Department of Agriculture, the Missouri Department of Transportation, the Office of Administration, the Office of the State Auditor, the Office of the State Courts Administrator, the Missouri Lottery Commission, the Kansas City Police Department, the St. Joseph Police Department, the St. Louis County Police Department, and the Phelps County Sheriff's Department assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other police and sheriff's departments were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not.
