FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

§§590.033, 590.040, and 590.080 – Peace officer standards

Officials from the Department of Public Safety - (Office of the Director, and Missouri Highway Patrol), the Attorney General's Office, the Department of Mental Health, the Department of Natural Resources, the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, the Department of Social Services, the Office of Administration, the Branson Police Department, the St. Louis County Police Department, and the Phelps County Sheriff's Department assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

In response to a previous version (SB 38), officials from the **Missouri Department of Conservation**, the **Kansas City Police Department**, and the **St. Joseph Police Department** each assumed the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note.

Officials from the **Oronogo Police Department** indicate this proposal would have a fiscal impact on their organization. However, **Oversight** notes they provided no information explaining the potential fiscal impact this proposal would have on their organization. Therefore, for fiscal note purposes, Oversight assumes any fiscal impact incurred by this police department would be absorbable within current funding levels.

Oversight only reflects the responses received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other local law enforcement were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A listing of political subdivisions included in the MOLIS database is available upon request.
