§162.611 – Metropolitan School Board Vacancies

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education**, the **Missouri Ethics Commission** and the **Office of the Secretary of State** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

In response to a similar proposal from this year, Perfected HCS for HB 497, officials from the **St. Louis City Board of Elections** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Officials from the St. Louis City did not respond to **Oversight’s** request for fiscal impact for this proposal.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION


This act provides that any school board vacancy that occurs in a metropolitan school board outside of the normal election cycle shall be filled by appointment by the board, instead of the mayor, for the remainder of the term.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.


