#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Department of Labor and Industrial Relations**, the **Department of Commerce and Insurance**, the **Missouri Department of Transportation**, the **Department of Revenue**, the **Department of Economic Development**, the **Missouri Department of Agriculture**, the **Missouri Department of Conservation**, and the **Office of Administration** each assume this proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective agencies.

In response to the similar proposal, SB 833 (2022), officials from the **Attorney General's Office** and the **Administrative Hearing Commission** both assumed the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organizations.

Officials from the University of Missouri System assume this proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Officials from the **City of Kansas** and **City of Springfield** both assume this proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

**Oversight** notes the above mentioned agencies, universities, and local political organization each have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, **Oversight** will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.
