FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Repeals §190.134 and implements §§190.100, 650.320, and 650.340

Officials from the **Department of Health and Senior Services**, the **Department of Public Safety – (Fire Safety, Office of the Director, and Missouri Highway Patrol)**, the **Kansas City Police Department**, the **St. Joseph Police Department**, the **St. Louis County Police Department**, the **Phelps County Sheriff’s Department**, and the **Webster Groves Fire Department** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note.

Oversight only reflects the responses received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other ambulance and EMS, local law enforcement, and fire protection districts were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A listing of political subdivisions included in the Missouri Legislative Information System (MOLIS) database is available upon request.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION
