ASSUMPTION

Repeals §190.134 and implements §§190.100, 650.320, and 650.340

Officials from the Department of Health and Senior Services, the Department of Public Safety – (Fire Safety, Office of the Director, and Missouri Highway Patrol), the Kansas City Police Department, the St. Joseph Police Department, the St. Louis County Police Department, the Phelps County Sheriff's Department, and the Webster Groves Fire Department assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note.

Oversight only reflects the responses received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other ambulance and EMS, local law enforcement, and fire protection districts were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not.
