FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the Office of Administration, Division of Facilities Management, Design and Construction (OA) state they do not make public the appraisal values for property that may be sold or conveyed because public knowledge of such information may hinder the State's ability to gain the best value for the property. Additionally, since the terms of conveyances are yet to be determined, the fiscal impact, if any, cannot be calculated. Therefore, the fiscal impact is \$0 to unknown.

Officials from the **Missouri Department of Transportation** and **Office of the Governor** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

In response to a similar proposal from 2023 (HB 886), officials from the **Attorney General's Office** assumed the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their organization. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note.

Oversight notes this proposal conveys a parcel of property of land from the state to the Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT) for \$1 or less (for land containing 1 8/10 acres more or less). Oversight assumes the fiscal impacts of this transaction to OA and MoDOT are <u>not</u> material and therefore we will not reflect a fiscal impact from this conveyance.
