#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Department of Natural Resources** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note.

Officials from the **Wayne County Public Water Supply District #2** assume there will be a fiscal impact but did not indicate what that fiscal impact would be.

**Oversight** assumes there will be no fiscal impact to water companies/districts as a result of this proposal. Oversight notes the proposal changes the testing of every hydrant in the community water system to "scheduled" rather than "annual".

Officials from the Morgan County Public Water Supply District #2, St. Charles County Public Water Supply District #2, Metropolitan St. Louis Sewer District and South River Drainage District each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.
