FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Section 227.841 – Road Naming

Officials from the **Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT)** state SB 1067 is estimated to have a total negative impact on the State Road Fund of \$4,000. This would be a one-time expense as the language requires MoDOT to fund this designation with no costs for sign fabrication and installation recouped through the participation fee. The estimated cost is \$2,000 per sign, with 2 total signs for this designation.

Oversight has no information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will present the fiscal impact of this proposal as provided by MoDOT.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This act designates "Police Chief Mason Griffith Memorial Highway" in Gasconade County. Costs for the designation shall be paid by the Department of Transportation.


This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
