#### FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** and the **City of Kansas City** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

In response to a similar proposal from 2023 (Perfected SS for SB 222), officials from the **Attorney General's Office** assumed the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their organization.

**Oversight** notes that the above mentioned agencies have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

**Oversight** only reflects the responses received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other local political subdivisions were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not.
