ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Missouri Department of Agriculture (MDA)**, **Department of Health and Senior Services** and **Missouri Highway Patrol** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

MDA notes, as a result of the 2023 legislative session, the industrial hemp statutes were repealed. The rules for that program are currently being rescinded and there are no staff or vacancies for this program. The program has been taken over by the USDA.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This bill appears to have no direct fiscal impact.


This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
