#### **FISCAL ANALYSIS**

#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the Department of Commerce and Insurance, the Missouri House of Representatives, the Missouri Senate, the Metropolitan St. Louis Sewer District, the South River Drainage District, the St. Charles County Pwsd, the Wayne County Pwsd and the Hancock Street Light District each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

In response to a similar proposal from last year (SB 568), officials from the **City of Springfield** and **Kansas City** each assumed the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

**Oversight** notes that the above mentioned agencies have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

**Oversight** only reflects the responses received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other cities and counties were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A listing of political subdivisions included in the Missouri Legislative Information System (MOLIS) database is available upon request.
