#### **ASSUMPTION**

§191.656 - Information concerning a person's HIV status or HIV testing

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety (DPS) - Missouri Highway Patrol (MHP)** defer to the Missouri Department of Transportation for the potential fiscal impact of this proposal.

**Oversight** notes DPS/MHP's deferral to MODOT for a statement of fiscal impact; for fiscal note purposes, Oversight assumes no fiscal impact for DPS/MHP.

Officials from the Department of Commerce and Insurance, the Department of Corrections, the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, the Department of Health and Senior Services, the Department of Higher Education and Workforce Development, the Department of Mental Health, the Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan, the Missouri Department of Transportation and the Newton County Health Department each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

**Oversight** only reflects the responses received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other hospitals and local public health agencies were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A listing of political subdivisions included in the Missouri Legislative Information System (MOLIS) database is available upon request.
