FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Commerce and Insurance** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note.

Officials from the **Morgan County Public Water Supply District #2** and **Pulaski County Sewer District #1** each assume the proposal will have a fiscal impact but did not indicate what that impact would be.

Oversight cannot determine a <u>direct</u> fiscal impact to these organizations; therefore, Oversight will not reflect a fiscal impact.

Officials from the Metropolitan St. Louise Sewer District, South River Drainage District, St. Charles County Public Water Supply District #2 and Wayne County Public Water Supply District #2 each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

Oversight only reflects the responses received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other water and sewer districts were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not.
