ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Natural Resources** and **Missouri Office of Prosecution Services** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

In response to a previous version, officials from the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** assumed the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Oversight notes that the above mentioned agencies have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Oversight assumes any fiscal impact from the class A misdemeanor charge would not be material. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION


The proposed legislation appears to have no direct fiscal impact.
