FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

§590.1100 – Automated license plate reader systems

Officials from the **Department of Revenue**, the **Department of Public Safety (DPS) – Director’s Office** and the **Missouri Highway Patrol**, the **Missouri Department of Transportation**, the **Missouri National Guard**, the **Phelps County Sheriff’s Office** and the **Kansas City Police Department** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

Officials from the **City of Kansas City** state the proposed legislation will have a negative fiscal impact of an indeterminate amount.

Oversight has no information to the contrary. Oversight assumes any impact the City of Kansas City might have will be minimal and absorbable within current funding levels; therefore, Oversight will present no fiscal impact for this local government.

In response to similar legislation from the current session (SB 1334), officials from the **City of Osceola** assumed the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Oversight only reflects the responses received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other cities, various county officials, sheriffs and police departments were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A listing of political subdivisions included in the Missouri Legislative Information System (MOLIS) database is available upon request.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION

The proposed legislation appears to have no direct fiscal impact.


This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
