### **ASSUMPTION**

#### <u>§191.648 – Expedited partner therapy</u>

Officials from the **Department of Health and Senior Services**, the **Department of Commerce** and **Insurance**, the **Department of Social Services** and the **Newton County Health Department** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

**Oversight** only reflects the responses received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other public health departments were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not.
