ASSUMPTION

§88.073 – Condemnation of Property of Religious Organizations

Officials from **Kansas City** assume a negative impact of an indeterminate amount.

Officials from the **City of Springfield** assume a negative fiscal impact, but the degree of impact is uncertain.

Oversight assumes the potential negative impact from the provisions of this proposal would be more of an <u>indirect impact</u>. Therefore, Oversight will reflect no direct fiscal impact from this proposal.

Officials from the **State Tax Commission** and the **Office of the Secretary of State** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

Oversight only reflects the responses received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other cities were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not.
