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## FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### **ASSUMPTION**

#### Section 37.1310 - Missouri Geospatial Advisory Council

Officials from the **Office of Administration (OA)** assume some of the duties outlined in the legislation would require staff and resources. The bill also allows for members of the council to be reimbursed for actual and necessary expenses. Some duties described in the bill overlap current duties managed through OA/ITSD Office of Geospatial Information (OGI). At this time, ITSD assumes that the impact of this legislation would be minimal and could be absorbed with existing staff and resources.

**Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note.

Officials from the **Missouri Department of Agriculture (MDA)** assume this legislation would require the Director of the Missouri Department of Agriculture to travel a 300 mile round trip (MDA office to Kansas City, MO) for 12 meetings. Fiscal impact would include mileage (\$0.66 per mile) and a \$48 meal per diem per day. MDA would incur a total fiscal impact of \$2,952 in FY 2026, \$3,011 in FY 2027 and \$3,071 in FY 2028 to implement the changes in this proposal.

Officials from the **Missouri State Senate** anticipate a negative fiscal impact to reimburse one Senator for travel to Geospatial Advisory Council meetings. In summary, it will cost approximately \$2,012.16 per year.

**Oversight** notes the new council will consist of roughly 34 members, meets monthly and the members will be reimbursed for actual and necessary expenses. Oversight assumes this proposal will require roughly \$50,000 in expense reimbursement to the 34 members for 12 meetings (34 members x 12 meetings per year x \$122 in expenses (mileage, meals, etc.)). Oversight will reflect the cost to various state funds as could exceed \$50,000.

Officials from the Department of Economic Development, the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, the Department of Higher Education and Workforce Development, the Department of Health and Senior Services, the Department of Natural Resources, the Department of Revenue, the Department of Public Safety – Directors Office, the Missouri Department of Conservation, the Missouri Department of Transportation, Missouri National Guard, the University of Missouri and the Missouri House of Representatives assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. In response to a similar proposal from last year (SB 1039), officials from the **Department of Social Services** assumed the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

**Oversight** notes that the above mentioned agencies have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note for these agencies.

# FISCAL IMPACT – Small Business

### FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This act establishes the Missouri Geospatial Advisory Council within the Office of Administration. The Council is charged with assisting and advising the state in ensuring the availability, implementation, and enhancement of a statewide geospatial data infrastructure common to all jurisdictions through research, planning, training, and education. Appointed members of the Council shall serve three-year terms and shall serve until their successors are appointed. The duties and responsibilities of the Council are described in the act.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
