ASSUMPTION

Repeals § 194.321 – Relating to COVID-19 vaccination status and organ transplants

Officials from the **Department of Health and Senior Services** and the **Department of Social Services** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

Oversight only reflects the responses received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, hospitals were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A general listing of political subdivisions included in the Missouri Legislative Information System (MOLIS) database is available upon request.

Oversight notes §194.321 was added in 2022 in HB 2331 (merged with SB 710) and no fiscal impact was attributed to this section in those fiscal notes.
