FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

§304.022 – Modifies definition of emergency vehicles

Officials from the Department of Natural Resources, the Department of Public Safety – Capitol Police and the Missouri Highway Patrol, the Department of Social Services, the Missouri Department of Conservation, the Missouri Department of Transportation, the Office of the State Public Defender, the City of Kansas City, the City of O'Fallon, the Phelps County Sheriff's Department, the Kansas City Police Department, the Springfield Police Department, the St. Louis County Police Department, and the Office of the State Courts Administrator each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Oversight notes that the above agencies have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

In response to similar legislation from the prior year (SB 1476), officials from the **Missouri Office of Prosecution Services** assumed the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other cities, various county officials, sheriffs' and police departments were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A general listing of political subdivisions included in our database is available upon request.
