### FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### **ASSUMPTION**

§§ 404.1100 to 404.1110 - "Designated Health Care Decision-Maker Act"

Officials from the Department of Commerce and Insurance, the Department of Health and Senior Services, the Department of Mental Health, the Department of Public Safety - Missouri Veterans Commission, the Department of Social Services and the Office of the State Courts Administrator each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

**Oversight** only reflects the responses received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other nursing homes, public administrators and hospitals were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A listing of political subdivisions included in the Missouri Legislative Information System (MOLIS) database is available upon request.
