FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Oversight was unable to receive some of the agency responses in a timely manner due to the short fiscal note request time. Oversight has presented this fiscal note on the best current information that we have or on prior year information regarding a similar bill. Upon the receipt of agency responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval to publish a new fiscal note.

§§215.034 and 215.036 – Emergency Aid

Officials from the **Department of Health and Senior Services**, the **Department of Public Safety - State Emergency Management Agency** and the **Department of Social Services** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

Oversight assumes the appropriation from the General Revenue Fund to the Missouri Housing Trust Fund and the transfer-out of funds to the Missouri Housing Development Commission will have a net effect of \$0. The \$0 or unknown transfer amounts are assumed to exceed \$250,000.

Officials from the **Department of Economic Development**, the **Office of the Governor**, the **Office of Administration** and the **Office of the State Treasurer** did not respond to Oversight's request for a statement of fiscal impact.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION

Upon a request for a presidential disaster declaration by the Governor, moneys appropriated to the Missouri Housing Trust Fund for the purpose of emergency aid shall be immediately transferred to the Missouri Housing Development Commission. Administrative costs and burdens may be waived to expedite the delivery of disaster relief assistance.

This act contains an emergency clause. (§§215.034 and 215.036)

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
